

## AIG Private Client Group Hurricane Protection & Outreach Authorization Form

I am the owner of the residence indicated below, and I have a homeowners insurance policy covering this residence through Private Client Group (hereinafter referred to as "PCG"). In the event of a field response I hereby authorize vendors of my insurance company (the "Service Providers") to assess the exterior of my property and coordinate short-term repairs after a hurricane has damaged my property (the "Services") by PCG preferred vendor companies. The intent being that these Services may reduce the risk of further loss or damage to my property.

I understand that once I sign this authorization, the Service Providers may access the exterior of my house at any time after a hurricane in order to provide the Services.

I understand and acknowledge that the services provided by the Service Providers may not prevent damage to my property or residence. I also understand that there is no guarantee that the Service Providers will be able to provide the Services to my property. I AGREE THAT THE SERVICES PROVIDED ARE "AS IS" AND THAT MY INSURANCE COMPANY AND THE SERVICE PROVIDERS SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES TO THE SERVICES EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY STATED HEREIN.

I understand that as a policyholder I will not be charged for the Services; the Hurricane Protection and Outreach will submit a claim on my behalf to cover the fees for this service. The claim will be coded as catastrophe related so there will be no adverse rating in my claim history. PCG has the right to terminate the Services at any time and for any reason. I understand that the Services will automatically terminate if I am no longer a policyholder. I also understand that my participation is totally voluntary.
